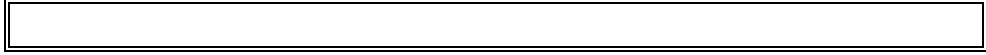

Introduction

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sew." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will

strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits, adventures, travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

The Past Life Chart Structure

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

The Passport

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

Node in Libra

You had a history of seeking relationships that maintained or restored your balance. One of your key impulses was an appreciation of beauty. Your soul was normally eager to reincarnate, knowing the world offered a huge panorama in which to explore your love and aesthetic interests. The archetypal theme for your destiny was to be a mediator. A

crucial lesson was to realize you couldn't please everyone all of the time. You tended to forget who you really were when distracted by so many different pulls upon you.

When you developed a deeper awareness of people, your perceptions guided you how to give and take freely. In other words, rather than being over accommodating, you became assertive for what you needed. A trickster was growing too aggressive. You became too self-centered. Finding a way to balance the scales of too much compromising with that of grabbing the attention back to you was paramount to feeling happy. You sometimes had to get angry or be a warrior to get results. You looked for meaning in finding experiences that mirrored back to you with clarity what you were seeking. Rushing impulsively into situations caused you to repeat the same mistakes. Walking gracefully, not necessarily slowly, with an inner assuredness, often attracted the right soul mate and circumstances that kept the scales near the middle of fulfillment.

Node in 3rd house

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? It most definitely was anything or anyone that stimulated your mind. If you got too scattered there was a bit of frustration in trying to concentrate. A common concern was "how can I reach the depths of my learning ability?" When you took the time to seek expansive enough life interests, you managed to stay out of karma's way. What sorts of experiences motivated you? A big one was communication! Following right behind it was an insatiable drive to be educated, whether traditionally or unconventionally. Being a networker or broadcaster of a message was another theme. Your energy levels peaked when finding a diversified lifestyle that constantly breathed in refreshing new information. Growing too one-dimensional is what deflated the air out of your balloon. Keeping your eyes on a broad perspective with an eclectic panache is what brought out a free-spiritedness. When you sought to share your knowledge openly this kept you on track as much as embracing a too narrow belief system was derailing. Somewhere always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks were highly perceptive instincts mixed with a tinge of not really wanting to be limited by reality. When using this wisely and insightfully, life was colored with great variety, never stopping long enough to be bored.

Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression

Sun in Scorpio:

The sign of Scorpio the scorpion lighted the mid-fall astrological skies at your birth in this life. Let's explore the significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Scorpio is "I penetrate". You had a repeating pattern of delving beneath the surface of things. Emotional intensity followed you from one incarnation to another.

Archetypes for Scorpio include the detective, researcher and even mystic. A probing set of eyes you displayed. An attraction to emotional crises and living near the edge did occur regularly. You exhibited a no nonsense mentality continuously. You really liked to scope out a situation before investing heavily in it. The taboos of your society didn't

bother you all that much. Trusting someone did! Yes, it was close relationships that pushed your buttons. Passion made you feel alive. Though you reached a point in many incarnations where peace of mind started to not seem so boring after all.

A cosmic principle at work through many of your lives was to get quite attached to what you felt belonged to you. This did make for some intense lessons if you tried to manipulate people. You found lovers or others didn't always respond positively to having power over them. When you were the object of someone else's manipulation, you could erupt angrily. You found ego strength in believing in your survival instincts. A great rebirth occurred when you found the courage to leave behind the past. Facing your shadows and fears made you a stronger person. You had a capacity to focus almost hypnotically on subjects of interest. Forgiveness of self or those closest to you taught you much. You came into this life solarized through a sign promoting empowerment. This was a theme that ran throughout your incarnations and was a key to self-mastery. When you didn't run from challenges, you were a powerful force!

Sun in 1st House

You had solar power personified that put you in the limelight regularly in previous lives. There was a tendency to attract attention through your actions. Your creative vitality danced circles around everybody else. Receiving attention made you feel valuable. Those ignoring you didn't become your best friends. Greeting new experiences excitedly came naturally. Your will power was a thing in motion, needing several outlets so that you didn't steam roll over the needs of others. Leadership roles gave you a chance to show off your talents. You weren't all that shy. As a matter of fact you could become downright pushy! Waiting around for permission to be yourself wasn't your style. Confidence came when you didn't look back for approval.

If there was a challenge, it was learning how not to step on a lover or friend's toes when pursuing your dreams. The leader and initiator lived brightly through you. Occupying center stage was gratifying. Your self-expression blossomed when you found the patience to get focused. The world responded positively when you portrayed boldness, but turned a cold shoulder when you acted either too arrogant, or as though you had no determination. You found fulfillment when you walked your talk with a vision that was sustained by inspiration.

Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings

Moon in Aries:

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Aries. What does this say about your past life tendencies? An instinctual fighting spirit allowed you to survive calamities and dilemmas. The family ancestries in past lives were linked by a pioneering spirit. You searched your soul for the courage to act decisively.

Your inner landscapes were colored with a restless atmosphere for adventure. Competition pumped you with a feisty attitude. There were lives where you lacked the backbone of your convictions. A lack of initiative or just plain fear kept you from boldly

displaying your true self. You usually incarnated with a sense of urgency to move forward. Patience never came easy. Channeling anger constructively was the sign of true wisdom. As you matured, and found your true paths, the powers of concentration were cultivated. You preferred individuals who knew how to take care of themselves.

You never had a feeling of extreme permanence in many lives about where you resided. Moving seems to have fit your need to look for opportunities. Finding a location that satisfied your sense of adventure was foremost in your mind. Your subconscious called to you to seek those experiences that gave you a strong sense of identity and purpose.

Moon in 9th house

The Quest

Mercury: Communication, Perceptions and Logic

Mercury in Sagittarius

Jupiter in 2nd house

The Journey

Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility

Saturn in Sagittarius

Saturn in 12th house

Romance had its highs and lows. Balancing the extremes was important. You liked passionate relationships with a bit of mystery surrounding them. Though eventually you often looked for a comforting bond. A lack of trust caused you emotional upheavals. It was reassuring when you found a lover understanding your innermost needs.

A major challenge was addiction to love, sex, and other forms of escape. This isn't saying you always fell into these behaviors. When you found the clarity and strength to channel this intensity positively, life was more enjoyable. You wanted from the deepest part of your soul to create a life that reflected your self-mastery. You had strong dedication to those you loved and a determination to show the world your talents. You found transcendental growth through dealing with unfinished business from the past, and walking forcefully toward the challenges you instinctually knew would scare and fulfill you at the same time.

Neptune in 2nd house

In what way were you extra intuitive? It was in regard to beauty and comfort. You were infatuated with each of them equally. It's not that every lifetime was filled with luxury and lavish ownership. You naturally tuned into serenity. You became mesmerized in wanting wealth or pleasure. Your idealism made you determined to find adequate outlets for cherished plans. There were times when you lost resources through unclear boundaries and in trusting the wrong people.

It was a test to feel grounded when you let go of the stabilizing things. Though you could be as solid as a rock when feeling the inspiration of your beliefs. Your spirituality brought you great abundance whether in gold or emotional fulfillment. You operated with great clarity when motivated by a drive to share your belongings with others. Love

uplifted your self-esteem. It made you feel quite valuable. What was the biggest challenge? In staying away from a poverty consciousness. You felt not deserving, or guilty, in regard to the good things life had to offer. Faith transformed your denial into a passionate search for uplifting meaning. You searched for a purpose that deepened your resolve for inner peace.

Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion

Pluto in Virgo

Empowering yourself through using analytical ability was a past lives tendency. Perfection drove you on to try to do great things. Being reasonable in your expectations was wise. Extreme worry was sometimes a downfall. Curbing this tendency did make you happier and allowed for greater productivity. Charisma was exhibited through working forcefully at whatever you made your life mission. Escaping into projects made you less nervous. There was a habit of putting your heart and soul into a cause.

There was a shadow. What was it? Criticism. You could spot if something was out of place in a second. You did at times overly pick apart yourself or others. When you got this one under control, good fortune was never far away. Self-mastery was discovered through deciphering the ways to work smarter rather than harder. You found rebirth or a sense of fulfillment when overcoming negative thought patterns, and seeing that altered perceptions were truly miracles.

Pluto in 4th house

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? By letting few people know your real secrets. You liked to keep your distance until getting to know someone. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered through purging yourself of the past when it had run out of its usefulness. It's not that you liked fast change, quite the contrary. But you suffered less when cutting your losses, or seeing that there was a brighter future waiting elsewhere. A location for a residence was important in that you derived great strength from power places. If the energy wasn't right you felt out of sorts. A powerful self-examination manifested if your moods got out of control. A compulsive tendency to dig up the seed of your dreams before they came to fruition got you to ask thought provoking questions. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations associated with a fear of abandonment or loss. When you were able to face this thought pattern, a revitalized you was born.

Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact

together along the same circuit. The following aspects will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

Moon trine Mercury

Stress was not something you wanted that close to you. This doesn't mean you were not hard working. On the contrary you had the sense to know what was worth getting upset about in the first place. You did occasionally forget to put yourself first for extended time periods, but managed to pick good people to be close to you.

Moon trine Uranus

You had an easygoing approach about changes, flowing with whatever came along. Sometimes you needed a gentle nudge if you were too passive. A fondness for friends with a vision was part of your past. There was not a strong drive to pursue your goals until you found the subject matter or circumstances that jump-started your ignition. When you objectively perceived a clear sense of direction you moved with wonderful forethought.

Moon oppose Node

You usually linked with a partner when you were hoping to get support for your life directions. You never really liked to go it alone. This doesn't mean you had no independence. It's only saying your intuitive energies often got stimulated through your people connections. You did need to keep those dependency needs balanced. It was better when you didn't try to derive all of your meaning out of a relationship

Sun conjunct Venus

Relationships played a major role in your life. Being in love made you feel alive. Finding someone willing to let you be yourself was essential. Perhaps the biggest challenge was decisiveness. An attraction to exotic lovers didn't necessarily mean they were the right matches. It was a desire to share your life with a special soul mate that in the end was what added longevity to your romances. Equally important was finding a person with values you could relate to. Over indulgence in the good things on life's plate had to be watched.

Sun square Pluto

If you're reading this one, you were intense. Each incarnation asked you to work on yourself profoundly. Finding out what you were hiding from yourself opened up a bigger amount of wonderful daylight. Letting go of possessiveness and manipulation freed you. Breaking away from those trying to enslave you was a must. You weren't supposed to go to extremes with power, and it's true that individuals jealous of it regularly challenged your strength. Revenge never brought you the best results but it felt good. Creative drives were awesome. Success occurred through being real business savvy. Exploring a subject deeply made you act like a detective in wanting to learn it inside and out. An attachment to lovers was compulsive. Sometimes you won, sometimes you lost. Romance went smoother when you learned to let go and flow, not easy to do! Passionate people spoke to your heart. It was essential that you joined forces with those having your best interests in mind in the long run.

Mercury conjunct Saturn

Serious thinking became a dominant force usually before you knew it. You were capable of long-term focus that enabled you to accomplish very difficult tasks. If you managed not to try to overly control situations they were more enjoyable. Business perceptions were very strong and accurate. If you were terribly disappointed over a failure or rejection, depression often resulted. Getting through this dilemma took patience and it didn't hurt if there were helpful allies. You always needed to be careful in demanding success according to a rigid plan. Flexibility was the best policy. Being your own person required you to break free from the rules established by others.

Venus square Pluto

Wow! Relationships pushed you to the limits. Passion was big. You attracted

powerful individuals more often than not. Power struggles were not uncommon. You had to fight to keep from being controlled. Possessiveness and manipulation came between you and others. You were happiest when at least a minimum degree of trust was established. Loyalty was strong when you found someone worth going through emotional turmoil for. A rebirth of sorts occurred when you channeled destructive energy into more productive pursuits. Getting a handle on compulsive desires was empowering. You needed a strong partner to deal with your moods. Though sometimes it was just as much a lover with explosive emotional outbursts. You frequently got stronger after surviving losses and setbacks. This awakened a drive to get on with your life. Gaining emotional stability was a test.

Mars oppose Jupiter

You liked expressing your philosophy rather boldly. When teaching or sharing your experiences you became very enthusiastic. You entered relationships fast as you wanted to see immediately what someone was truly like. Sometimes you learned to slow down and get to know a person first. Patience was a real test. You liked individuals not afraid of new experiences. Your intensity was ignited through the people you knew. You didn't really like commitments because they limited your options. Though when you got focused you did have plenty of fire to put into your favorite pastimes.

Mars square Uranus

If you are reading this one you liked a fast pace in most incarnations, that is, unless you burned out. Taking your time wasn't the first impulse. Leaping ahead was! You pushed your ideas until others listened. You did run for your life a few times when the average contemporary had enough of your revolutionary, maybe even hedonistic ways. There were lives where you channeled this energy powerfully into bold inventiveness. Yes, you were trend setting. Your friends may have found you eccentric, but never boring. You liked those with minds that thought in unique ways, like your own. Rules and conformity irritated you. A revolutionary mentality caused you to detest restrictive authority figures. When you did learn patience, it helped you make less enemies and to hold onto your closest allies. Surprises made life worth living.

Mars square Midheaven

Fast impulses played a big part in your past. Keeping your public and private lives balanced was a challenge. You vacillated between being totally dedicated to careers and causes, to someone who would rather be at home. Your relationships and partnerships felt the impact of your emotional intensity. Your moods were quite changeable. You could get into a good one just as quickly as getting into a bad one. You were a fighter and didn't surrender easily. It was your great determination to outlast others that made you a winner. Of course, some battles were not worth fighting. People did wish you didn't take your problems out on them.

Mars oppose Ascendant

Dealing directly with others was your preference. When you lacked assertiveness it threw your relationships out of balance. There were times due to being in limiting circumstances that your identity was confused. You did have your share of fighting against those trying to keep you confined to a lifestyle you couldn't swallow. Indecision about which battles were worth getting into did make you uneasy. There were tendencies to seek out companions that could deal with your angry side. Mild mannered individuals weren't as comfortable in associating with you as the feistier types. You were happier when acting spontaneously though it helped when you were conscious of the impact of your actions.

Jupiter square Uranus

Living for tomorrow meant more to you than today. You weren't the most reliable person in the world. Commitments were easily broken. Continuity didn't interest you as much as newness. You had a far-reaching vision that quickly outgrew the present. It really took a special someone or something, to get you to stop in your tracks long enough to get focused. Revolutionary ideas and actions continuously circulated through your brain. Were you ever able to finish what you started? Yes! When an interest that didn't get boring corralled your attention. In whatever you took seriously, your insights excited others. Sarcasm alienated people. You liked shocking others and being surprised.

Jupiter square Midheaven

Being organized wasn't an immediate impulse. You liked to act first and think later. Following hunches occasionally paid off, but sometimes didn't. Exaggerating your qualifications made others not believe you. Your dramatic side didn't bother anyone as much as promising more than could be delivered. Excess indulgences made discipline a challenge. You found absolute happiness when tapping into talents that earned you recognition. You realized eventually that real effort would take you to where you needed to be.

Jupiter conjunct Ascendant

An open mind allowed you to discover many ways to seek fulfillment. It was your positive outlook that brought good luck. Being tied down without any hope of freedom made you uneasy. Some perceived you to be unreliable and lacking focus. You saw this as a need to travel in search of more expansive growth. Staying away from narrow judgments made you more likeable and approachable.

Uranus oppose Midheaven

Balancing your private and public lives was a key to your sense of security. You didn't really like anyone upsetting your comfort zones though there was no end to you being a disruptive force in the lives of others. When someone tried to limit your freedom

is when you went to war. Those depending on you for support admired your freethinking style but were a bit concerned if they could really count on you. There were those times when you were lost in your causes and work. You didn't like people to infringe upon your need for space unless invited to do so.

Uranus square Ascendant

Ideas traveled through you at the speed of light, sometimes causing you to ride one suddenly onto a new highway. Your fast changes of direction made some think you to be undependable. You enjoyed shocking others with actions and thought-provoking ideas. It wasn't in your nature to be a copycat. You were trend setting for sure. Causing friction with no real purpose behind the action wasn't productive. You were quite a catalyst for change. Erratic inconsistencies in behavior proved problematic in maintaining closeness or finishing what you started out to do. When you discovered your unique personal style it did find you with a clearer sense of direction.

Midheaven trine Node

You believed in making effort but not forcing life to meet your demands. There was a quiet confidence that your ambition would be rewarded if you gave it your best. You were happier when staying true to a vast vision that incorporated experiences from all walks of the world.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.

Libra on 2nd house:

You had a tendency to weigh your options carefully. Making up your mind was testy. Indecision regarding major acquisitions sometimes plagued you. When you did develop a pattern of solid decision making life became easier. Over indulgence in food and drink sometimes got out of control. This was how you drowned your sorrows, especially after a love affair that went awry. Learning to deal directly with issues proved to be the wiser plan.

3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.

Virgo on 3rd house:

An analytical mind was readily at your disposal. The more dreamy side of life did not appeal to you as much as the reality dimension. Your perceptions were sharp when it

came to seeing life as sober. Worrying about what you couldn't control was bothersome. Sometimes your brain got too overloaded with needless information. A left brain burnout did occur if you didn't stop worrying about the details. Your mind was great for remembering the little things. Keeping a positive outlook took you much further than focusing on too many doubts. Mental toughness did help you in dealing with life's ups and downs. A compulsive striving for perfection had to be kept under control. Compulsive thinking sometimes got in the way of your feelings and intuition. When you trusted your intuitive side, life was more adventurous.

4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.

Leo on 4th house:

Power struggles with others did occur. It was a challenge to learn how to become a negotiator. Creating win-win situations was the real test. You remained close to those letting you express your true power. If you became obsessed with overpowering others, you made enemies. When you didn't compulsively crave attention you were happier. Finding a true sense of inner security brought harmony. There was a challenge in not letting your critics destroy your self-confidence.

5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.

Cancer on 5th house:

Your creative energy was nurtured by where you lived. Your moods were greatly aroused by your passion to create. It was important that you tapped into your intuition when expressing yourself. You showed great sensitivity about family members and lovers being supportive of your life endeavors. It hurt your ego when those you loved didn't pay enough attention to what mattered the most to you. When you were less bossy, people were more cooperative. When you found the self-confidence to take a risk, life often rewarded you. Waiting too long for approval caused missed opportunities. There was a repeating pattern of a tug of war within you to satisfy yourself, coupled with a drive to make others happy. Balancing these two tendencies helped keep you happy and healthy.

6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.

Gemini on 6th house:

You enjoyed learning in as many ways as possible, and had a deep desire to sharpen skills. Boredom you feared. You liked being as prepared as possible in order to anticipate change. Your delicate nervous system needed regular exercise to keep you mentally clear. A proneness to a lack of concentration was a test. You were happier when trying not to be too perfect. Accepting your flaws made for happier days. Worrying about what you couldn't change did at times get the best of you. Then again, a drive toward perfection brought out your best mental intensity. Finding the balance was the key. Heaven on earth was when you worked at careers or jobs that allowed you to operate from your highest levels of learning.

7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.

Taurus on 7th house:

You were attracted to stabilizing partners. Ambitious partnerships were highlighted. Being with someone you could work clearly with was a must. Your relationships ran the spectrum from having been subjected to possessive partners, to selecting people that respected your individuality. Lovers with calmer dispositions were preferred. You created greater wealth when aligning yourself with the right people. A hidden key to relationship success was finding people with similar values. Learning how to compromise and negotiate was essential to relationship harmony.

8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.

Aries on 8th house:

Being in intense partnerships colored past incarnations. This doesn't mean they were good or bad. It is only saying your lovers were passionate and maybe a bit reckless. People regularly challenged your power as a general rule. You had a strong survival instinct. Getting past a crisis sometimes took your greatest courage. It was important that you found ways to create stability. You needed partners that respected your autonomy. Tension over finances occurred more than once. You needed to know you had the freedom to make your own choices. Brooding over the past never did much for your happiness. Patience with those you loved was wise. You were not one to readily allow others to easily take advantage of you.

9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.

Pisces on 9th house:

You exuded a restless imagination. Your quest for self-understanding was underscored. A wandering spirit didn't always make you Mr. or Ms. Reliable. An adventurous mind kept you dreaming about the liveliest places to be. Faith meant everything to you. Knowing your limits wasn't usually learned easily. A big challenge was a fear of conflict. When you faced issues, you found inner strength and problems were easier to fix. Searching for love was a passion. Being realistic about people was another test. Certain causes led you astray when you lost touch with reality. Your devotional side needed to be kept in balance. You liked sharing knowledge as a way to inspire others to fulfill their potential.

10th House: Professions, ambition, leadership, focus, commitments.

Aquarius on 10th house:

A "Give me Liberty or give me Death" philosophy was not far from your thoughts. The roles in life you chose had an individuality theme running through them. A burning desire to keep reinventing yourself through your career was a repeating pattern. You needed a lot of latitude in work environments. Doing your own thing was preferable. Your progressive mind liked being the catalyst for change. Though the reaction to your insights wasn't always positive. If your ideas were too far out in front of your society, you

were met with resistance, maybe even exile. You didn't respect authority until it proved it could be trusted. Institutions seemed to move too slow for your liking. You only were inclined to work against change if it seemed to threaten your most cherished beliefs. Stubborn ideas that were traded in for flexible ones led to new opportunities.

11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.
Capricorn on 11th house:

You approached the future with reality based thinking. Change wasn't a welcomed sight. Your feet were planted firmly in the present. You had a deep desire to preserve the past. Fighting city hall wasn't your first impulse. Though city hall couldn't get you to budge if you were determined to make a point. You trusted people with clear logic and possessing intelligence. You respected individuals with integrity. When you became too rigid in setting your goals, people did become angry. Greater flexibility made you more popular. Delayed gratification was connected to your patience. You could focus persistently on long range goals unless you became negative. Losing confidence did take some steam out of your momentum. Self-imposed restrictions on your freedom caused missed opportunities. When you acted with courage and managed to cast aside doubts, you were more successful. Your wisdom came from not repeating past mistakes. Time in your eyes was a valuable teacher.

12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.
Sagittarius on 12th house:

You had ideals that reached to the farthest horizons. Faith was what you relied on to get you through the tough tests. A dedication to causes was intense. You did sometimes give too much of yourself and regret it later. Reality testing helped you in ascertaining how to define your boundaries. When you went through periods of self-doubt, your way out of this maze was to travel. A search for a soul mate usually began early. You liked to share your life with a lively partner. Knowing your limitations took time. Testing fate just for the experience happened with regularity. Your ideals had to be grounded. A divine discontent did occasionally make it hard to focus on plans for long periods of time. With practice, you learned how to follow through on what people expected of you. A need for escape was a primal call from within you. Making peace with your intuitive imagination and life's demands was a lifelong process.

Planets in actuality never really move backward, but can appear to do so. This is referred to as retrograde motion, and as you will read has special past life meaning surrounding a particular planet's symbolism. The following are planets that were moving retrograde at your birth with a description as to how this played out for you in other incarnations.

Mars retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had a challenge in determining the ways to express your warrior nature. What does this mean? Well for starters, in lives where you were too aggressive, you had to learn how to tone down your demands. What about the lives you weren't so direct? You needed to get more outspoken. The idea was to land somewhere in the middle on the assertion scale. You were happiest when sensing how to act spontaneously, with an instinct that didn't trample over the people in front of you. Actually, maybe it's more accurate to say your friends, family and lovers were ecstatic when you had great awareness of the impact of your movements and choices. If you became too timid in behavior, you tended to get confused. People took advantage of you. If you were a fighter with no sensitivity, the battles may have been won, but sooner or later a faster or better shooter caught up with you. There was excitement in overcoming challenges. You didn't really like losing control of your anger. When you stuffed it back it did explode. Knowing this slowed down or sharpened your response time. Your impulse to initiate new directions was at its best when guided by your intuition. Your raw energy to be a creative was aroused when finding the courage to transcend the obstacles in front of you.

Uranus Retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had unique goals, reserved just for you. When you didn't do this, life lacked meaning. When you solely served your own purposes this caused quite a ruffle in the feathers of those you loved and cared about. Finding the midstream worked the best regarding these two extremes of sacrifice and doing your own thing. Your ideas sent shock waves at times when individuals or collective bodies didn't like the message. You did sometimes tap into a collective trend before it became in vogue. It did make you nervous about how you might be judged. Many ideas were kept internalized until you were sure the coast was clear and safe enough to present the notions. Were you ever more outwardly disruptive? For sure! This usually occurred when you were so aroused by injustices or thinking restrictions imposed upon you. There was a need to perceive with fore thought, which fights were worth the struggle. Being different just to be different or starting conflicts with no purpose, were ways you took many steps in the wrong direction. Listening to cues from the universe on which directions promised accelerated growth was wise. Your vision of the future was as strong as the ability to remember what gave your imagination an electrifying sensation. Patience took effort!
